The important aspect of this challenge is that children can count forwards and backwards and from any number!

Mastering the facts

If your child knows these facts, can they use the facts to solve practical problems?
e.g. - 'I buy 5 boxes of pencils. In each box are 3 pencils. How many pencils will I have in total?'

Top Tips

Remind your child that this is the process of 'repeated addition'. You add '3' more on each time if counting forwards or take '3' away if counting back.

The secret to success is practising little and often. You could practise while walking to school or during a car journey. Online games can also help children practise their maths skills (*please see our website for suggestions*)
