



Maths Challenge

Foundation - Autumn Term 2

I can count beyond 10.

By the end of this half term, children should be able to count beyond 10.



Key Vocabulary

Counting

Numbers

Forwards

The important aspect of this challenge is that children can count forwards from any number!

Mastering the facts

If your child knows these facts, can they use them to count objects accurately to 10? Saying one number for each object as they count. You could encourage your child to count aloud, using different voices and actions to engage them. You could sing nursery rhymes and numbers songs to help your child learn. E.g. 10 green bottles standing on a wall, 1...2...3...4...5...6...7...8...9...10...BLAST OFF! Encourage your child to point to the numbers as they are saying them to develop number recognition. Once your child is confident at counting forwards to 10 practise counting to 15 and then 20.

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. You could go on a number hunt and look for numbers in the environment. E.g. Numbers on doors, buses and car registration plates etc.
