



Maths Challenge

Year 1 - Spring Term 2

I can recall all addition and subtraction facts to 6.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts and be able to recall them **instantly**.

For Example;

$$6 + 0 = 6$$

$$5 + 1 = 6$$

$$4 + 2 = 6$$

$$3 + 3 = 6$$

$$6 - 0 = 6$$

$$6 - 1 = 5$$

$$6 - 2 = 4$$

$$6 - 3 = 3$$

Key Vocabulary

Plus

Addition

Make

Subtract

Take away

Equals

The important aspect of this challenge is that children can recall the addition and subtraction facts quickly.

Mastering the facts

If your child knows these facts, they can practise solving addition and subtraction number sentences with missing numbers. For example $4 + \underline{\quad} = 6$.

You could also practise worded problems such as *I have 3 red cars and 3 yellow cars. How many cars do I have altogether?*

Top Tips

The secret to success is practising little and often. You could practise while walking to school or during a car journey. Online games can also help children practise their maths skills (*please see our website for suggestions*).
