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Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that we have some public health nurses visiting school from the 0-19 service to talk to the children about personal hygiene and the importance of handwashing. As part of this the children will be learning about keeping healthy and looking after themselves. The nurses will be attending school on **17/3/26**.

The particular focus on this day will be the importance of hand washing. The children will learn about the importance of effective hand washing based upon the recommended guidelines from Public Health England. This will involve them using the recommended hand washing procedure and then they will be using the ultra violet light machine that can show up germs left on the hands from ineffective hand washing.

The Nurses will then be talking to the children about how germs can spread following poor hand hygiene. They will learn about key times to wash hands along with demonstrations of good hand washing techniques. Hands often become contaminated allowing spread to the general environment by touching taps, toys, objects food and also touching each other. This will be a fun session for the children whilst integrating learning around health and keeping clean.

The hand wash that will be using is called GlitterBug Potion: Please find below the ingredients listed:

Water, Caprylyl Methicone, Glycerin, Hydrogenated polyisobutene, Bis (glycidoxyphenyl) propane/bisaminomethylbornane copolymer, Fluorescent brightener 230, Aluminium hydroxid, Acrylates copolymer, Stearic acid, Glyceryl stearate, PEG-100 stearate, Cetyl alcohol, Phenoxyethanol, Caprylyl glycol, Xanthan gum, Ethylhexylglycerin, Hexylene glycol Fragrance

Please be mindful if your child may have any allergies to any of the above properties.
