Year 2 Visit to Filey

Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of next half term's theme called 'Oh I do like to be beside the seaside' we have arranged a visit for Year 2 children to Filey on **Monday 27th April.**

On this day, children will need to arrive at school at the earlier time of 8:20am. Children should go to their classrooms on arrival as normal.

This will enable us to register the children ready for a prompt departure. We will return to school at around 4:30pm. (We will keep parents informed via Arbor or ClassDojo if there are any delays due to traffic etc).

All children will require a packed lunch, water bottle, waterproof coat and sun hat. They will need to wear school uniform and sensible shoes. If the weather is fine, please apply sunscreen before your child arrives at school. No spending money will be required.

Weather permitting, children will enjoy a walk around Filey to look at the features of the seaside, eat their lunch overlooking the sea and then have a visit to the beach.

We would like all children to bring their own small plastic buckets and spades to play on the beach. Please note, these must be able to fit in their rucksack as they will be walking with these for most of the day.

No seaside visit is complete without an ice cream, which school will pay for as a special treat!

The cost of this visit, which will include transport costs, will be £19.50 per child, which has been heavily subsidised by school.

If we don't receive enough contributions unfortunately, the visit may have to be cancelled.

Please give your parental consent and make payment via the Arbor Parent Portal by **Friday 24th April**, at the latest. (Please note payment can be made at any time from receipt of this letter via Arbor and can be paid in installments, if preferred.)
