## Y2 Transition to Rosehill Junior School

Dear parent/carer,

Your child is about to take an important step in their education as they progress from Key Stage 1 to Key Stage 2 so I have the pleasure in writing to begin the process of transition from Ryecroft to Rosehill. Firstly, thank you for choosing Rosehill. For many years, we have been strong partners with our colleagues at Ryecroft and both schools have worked closely to ensure the best opportunities for our children. We are now looking forward to welcoming you and your child to the Rosehill school community. We aim to work in close partnership with you to ensure an education of the best possible quality.

Our aim is to build upon the experiences the children have enjoyed at Ryecroft and give them a really positive start in their new school. We have planned a number of events over the next few weeks in order to facilitate a smooth transition to Rosehill. We will start with our **Y2 Parents' Transition Event at Rosehill on Tuesday 16th June**. At this meeting, you will have the opportunity to meet the Year 3 teachers and the Year 3 teacher for next year. The Welcome Event will officially start from 3:45pm but you are welcome to walk straight up to Rosehill after collecting your child from Ryecroft. The meeting will last no longer than 45 minutes.

You will soon be receiving our welcome pack, which contains lots of useful information about Rosehill Junior School, including how to book a place at Breakfast Club, what the school day looks like and what uniform your child will need.

On Friday 12th June, your child will visit Rosehill with their current teacher and have a short tour with the current Year 3 class teachers. The Year 2 children will be able to join the junior children out on the yard for playtime.

On Tuesday 7th July, your child will attend Rosehill for 3 full days (**Tuesday 7th July, Wednesday 8th July and Thursday 9th July**). This time helps them to get used to the routines and learning patterns of Year 3 which helps to reduce any anxieties about their new school, and help us to make a really productive start to the new school year in September. Over these three days, you will need to drop your child off at Rosehill from 8:30am, ready for an 8:45am start and collect them from Rosehill at 3pm.

We will keep you informed about the transition process and will contact you with any important information over the coming weeks.
