

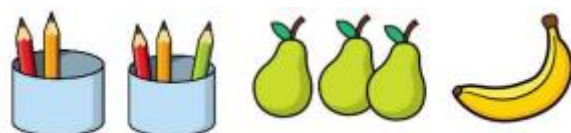
Reception Maths Homework

This week in Maths we have been exploring numbers 1, 2 and 3! To have a real understanding of these numbers we need to recognise groups of pictures or objects that may represent this number in different ways. The example below shows you the different ways to represent number 3.



Can you go on a hunt around your house to find the different numerals 1, 2 or 3 and objects or patterns that represent that number?

The next step would be to count and organise objects to match the numeral. The example below shows you 2 pencils, 3 pencils, 3 pears and 1 banana. Can you find objects around your house and count out 1, 2 and 3.
