This week in Maths we have been learning about circles and triangles. Following on from learning about the composition of numbers 1, 2 and 3 children have learnt that circles have 1 curved side and triangles have 3 straight sides.

The children are beginning to recognise that these shapes can be found on everyday objects and items both inside and outside.



Can you go on a shape hunt around your house and have a go at finding different objects shaped like a circle and triangle?

Can children have a go at making their own circles and triangles of different sizes? For example, you could use sticks to make a triangle.
