

Reception Maths Homework

This week in Maths we have been learning about spatial awareness. Children hear and begin to use positional language to describe how objects are positioned in relation to other objects.

This can be modelled and practised with children through their play. Tidy-up time is full of lots of opportunities to use positional language for a real purpose.

Using a toy give instructions to your child on where to put their toy. For example, 'put the teddy on top of your bed.'



Another activity that helps with spatial awareness is a treasure hunt. Set up a simple treasure hunt at home and provide picture clues. As your child goes to each place in the picture they can hunt for the next clue. Use positional language and allow children to describe where they have to go next.
