This week your child has been learning the following letter sounds as part of our phonics programme. Please work with your child to practise saying the following letter sounds.

Please remember: 1. We use letter sounds as in aaaa for ant not the letter names ANT. 2. We always start with our pencil in the correct place. 3. When there are two letters we call them 'special friends' as together they make one sound.

sh	th	ch	qu	ng
When writing this sound we say: Slither down the snake, down the head to the hooves and over his back.	When writing this sound we say: Down the tower, across the tower, down the head to the hooves and over his back.	When writing this sound we say: Curl around the caterpillar, down the head to the hooves and over his back.	When writing this sound we say: Round her head, up past her earring, down her hair, and flick. Down and under, up to the top and draw the puddle.	When writing this sound we say: Down nobby and over his net. Around the girls face, down her hair and give her a curl.
